



**Announcement of Si Than Subdistrict Administrative Organization**  
**On the policy of not accepting all gifts and gifts from duty (No Gift Policy)**  
**The fiscal year B.E.B.E. 2024**

In accordance with the Cabinet Resolution on 8 December 2020, the National Reform Plan for Anti-Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Version) was adopted by the government to carry out Big Rock, the 4th Reform Activities, to develop the Thai government system to be transparent and unprofitable. The first goal is 1.1 "All government agencies shall declare themselves to be agencies where all government officials do not accept gifts and gifts of all kinds from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy)."

In this regard, to drive reform activities in accordance with the aforementioned national reform plan, create transparency within the agency, create values for performing their duties and be a culture of integrity of Si Than Subdistrict Administrative Organization. Therefore, all executives, employees, officers and staff are not allowed to receive gifts and gifts from their duties before or after their duties. This will result in corruption and misconduct both now and in the future. The criteria for receiving gifts or gifts and any other benefits in accordance with the Prime Minister's Office Regulations on Giving or Receiving Gifts of Public Officials, B.E. shall be complied with. In 2001, The National Anti-Corruption Commission on the Criteria for the Acquisition of Property or Other Benefits by Public Officials, B.E. 25 In the year of 2020

The announcement was made to inform the general public that all executives, officers and personnel under the company should follow the policy strictly.
